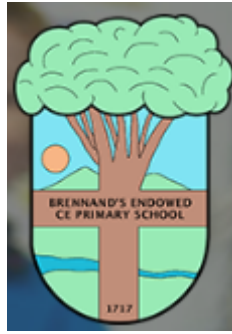

Loose Parts Play

We are excited to be developing Loose Parts Play in our playground as we head into the winter. Loose parts are open-ended materials—such as small tyres, drain pipes, planks of wood, crates and other everyday items—that children can move, combine, take apart and redesign in endless ways.

Playing with loose parts encourages creativity, problem-solving, teamwork and physical skills as children build, balance, construct and imagine. To help us create a rich play environment, we are looking for donations of clean, safe items such as:

- Small tyres (car or bike)
- Short drain pipes or guttering
- Planks of wood (smooth and splinter-free)
- Milk crates or sturdy boxes
- Large fabric pieces, ropes, or other interesting odds and ends


